FOOD PANTRY

Back in the fall we had a wonderful outpouring of gifts to support our food pantry. Thank you again for all who have been a part of that through donations and/or prayer. This is an ongoing opportunity for us to support the individuals and families of our community. With the winter months, the types of food we can put out has changed. We are looking for items that can withstand freezing temperatures, especially dried foods. Canned food and jars with liquid (such as juice, canned beans, vegetables and fruit) can expand and break in cold temperatures. You are still welcome to donate such items, but they will not be able to be used until more consistently warm temperatures are here.

If you would like to contribute at any time of the year, there are two options. You are welcome to drive by and put your items in the food pantry facing Armstrong Ave. at any time as room is available. The other option is to schedule a time to bring donations to the church, where they will be stored in the basement kitchen. The pantry will then be restocked as needed. Worship Plans and Adjustments

As vaccinations continue to go forward in our state and as the weather continues to warm, we have a number of opportunities we are looking forward to with our worship services. This will be a wonderful opportunity as the weather continues to warm. The church choir is permitted to practice outdoors and sing outdoors as well. Funeral services are available to be scheduled, but only for immediate family (not extended) at this time. Masks and distance are still required at all church functions. A next step that we are looking at in the months ahead is the lengthening of worship services back to an hour. For now, we continue to hold 30 minute services beginning at 9:00 am on Sunday. As always, we hold these plans knowing that the situation could change again and thus, we might have to change again as well. We continue to monitor the situation in our state and in our county and are approaching changes cautiously and carefully. We desire to be safe in love for all of you and our community.
